# **Constructing a personal statement**

Four key sections

- About you what kind of person are you? (Tell the post 16 provider how brilliant you are and what you are proud of!)
- 2. What have you done in school? (Subjects studied and favourite subjects but other achievements and successes you are proud of!)
- **3.** What do you do outside of school? (Hobbies, interests and commitments and the skills and qualities this has helped you to develop.)
- **4. Summing up** (Finish with a flourish including any career aspirations or plans for the future.)



# **Personal statement – key reminders**

- Show your unique strengths be proud!
- Be enthusiastic but be truthful.
- Provide examples of how you demonstrate skills and qualities.
- Relate to any aspirations you have if applicable.
- Expect to produce several drafts.
- Proofread as many times as possible.
- Ask people you trust for their feedback.
- Ensure you have provided enough detail.
